



## COVID 19 PROCEDURES

**Following latest advice from the Government on social distancing we have implemented a range of procedures at our venues to minimise the need for contact between people when attending track and test days. These changes are intended to be both practical and more convenient for customers, whilst providing reassurance that we're doing everything we can to keep you safe.**

### REGISTRATION

- All pre-event registration & safety briefings have been moved online in advance of the event and is mandatory for all drivers. Event details and links will be sent out via email to participants before each event.
- On arrival, participants still need to check in to have their driving licences checked and to collect their own wristband & vehicle sticker which must be displayed throughout the event.
- You must observe 2 metre social distancing rules at all times.
- A member of staff will be present in the wristband collection area, behind a Perspex safety screen, to deal with any issues and queries (only).
- Hand sanitiser will be widely available, it is helpful to bring your own however.

### FOOD & DRINK

- Most circuits will continue to offer a takeaway or mobile catering style service with a limited hot food menu and additional safety measures in place, see event instructions. All customers are welcome to bring their own food and drink to the circuit.
- Face masks must be worn inside for venues where the catering is not based outdoors.

### GARAGES & PADDOCK AREA

- On trackdays, access will be restricted to one car and two people per single garage.
- Garages will remain fully open at all times (to the front and rear).

### ADDITIONAL POINTS

- Only participants and their essential helpers may attend a test or track day. No-one else, including spectating friends or family members, will be permitted.
- Attendees must observe the 'Rule of Six' at all times when on site and remain socially distanced to others.
- Drivers from different households are permitted to share a vehicle providing the vehicle is sanitised between use.
- Passengers are only permitted if they are from the same household or part of your 'support bubble'.
- In-car instruction from Javelin Trackdays is not available at this time.
- Helmets are not available for hire.
- Private instruction is now permitted on our events providing the driver and instructor each have either a full face helmet with visors closed, or open face helmets with a face mask. Instructors must be declared no later than 48 hours prior to the event in writing to us and they must present their ARDS Instructor Licence during check in at the venue.
- Overnight stays prior to events for participants & essential helpers only are now permitted again from the 4<sup>th</sup> July at applicable circuits. Limited facilities will be available overnight i.e. just toilets, no showers.
- Facemasks must be worn for all indoor areas (including check in) until further notice.

**IMPORTANT:** You must not attend an activity if you have any symptoms of Covid-19, or you are required to self-isolate under Government guidelines. Please notify us as soon as possible and complete the cancellation form on the website prior to the event.
